_____ **Home and School Association**

Help to communicate the efforts of the chairpersons for large fundraising efforts. Members act as liaison to School Board, parents and OLP staff as well as participate in marketing the school to the community. Coordinate meetings and facilitate parent efforts within the school.

_____ **Christian Services**

This committee is organized as a service outreach program to our local community, Helping the teachers and students in their charitable endeavors. Main responsibilities include the Walk-a-Thon and Christmas collections.

_____ **Cultural**

This group of volunteers plans academic assemblies, workshops, and various other activities. They also help coordinate the Book Fair as well as invite various authors and performances into the school.

_____ **Hospitality**

Volunteers are asked to cook for and provide food items (e.g., salads, desserts) and assist in monthly faculty appreciation luncheons on a rotating basis.

They participate in the Ice Cream Social and Grandparents Day as well as assist in miscellaneous functions throughout the year.

Auction Committee

This group works together to coordinate the Auction/Dinner fundraiser held in the third quarter of the year. Many sub-committees are formed throughout the school year, but an initial group of volunteers is needed to begin this effort.

Market Day

Many volunteers are needed one Friday per month from 1:00-3:15 p.m. These volunteers help fill, distribute, and double-check orders. By volunteering once a month, you will meet new people. Small children are welcome!

Lunch Duty

More than ever, volunteers are needed to give one or more days per week to supervise students during the lunch hour. This is essential to ensure the safety and well being of the children. Safety Patrol
