

Marriage Preparation Program

Parishes have the responsibility of preparing their parishioners to receive the Sacrament of Matrimony. Depending upon the specific circumstances of the bride and/or groom (particularly in the case of different religious or faith beliefs and if the wedding is to take place at a non-Catholic church) special instructions, permissions, and dispensations will be needed. Consequently, marriage preparation should begin at least 9 months prior to your wedding.

If your plans include marrying at Our Lady of Peace and you have a wedding date in mind, call the Rectory, 630-323-4333 Ext. 23 and leave a message for Deacon Larry. He will contact you and enter your date in the marriage book. One year prior to your desired date is not too soon to call. It's important to reserve your church date and time before you schedule your reception.
